## Canadian Parents for French PEI announces the winner of its Educator of the Year Award

The award is presented annually to a person who has shown exceptional support and dedication to the quality and availability of French language programs in PEI schools. This year's recipient is Nancy Kitson a French Immersion Kindergarten teacher at Glen Stewart Primary.



One parent wrote: "... my son, is fortunate enough to be in her class. Mme Kitson is an outstanding teacher who not only teaches the French language to five year old students, but also fosters an excitement for and a love of that language. Mme Kitson engages all learners, even the most reluctant. She develops and promotes activities that engage the students and make them excited to go to school. I cannot count the number of mornings my son has jumped out of bed, excited to get to school due to something Madame has planned for that day." From a fellow teacher: "As a French Immersion teacher, Nancy understands the importance of helping the children understand and appreciate the French language outside the classroom-she makes sure that it is a living language for them. She provides opportunities for them to see French in action in non-academic, real-life activities." Finally from

another parent: "Every week my children come home with wonderful stories about what they did with Mme Kitson at school. She is so passionate about the French language and this is shared with the children and spreads, they love going to school and learning French!"

It was with great pleasure that CPF PEI along with all the FI Kindergarten students, Minister Currie, fellow teachers and administration, her son Julien, husband Joey, parents and in-laws, were in attendance to present this award. As part of the award Madame Kitson received over \$1400 in prizes including a Mimeo Teach Interactive System technology that turns any white board into an interactive board, a banner for her classroom, a trophy, a gift card and an allowance for her classroom or to further her education.
