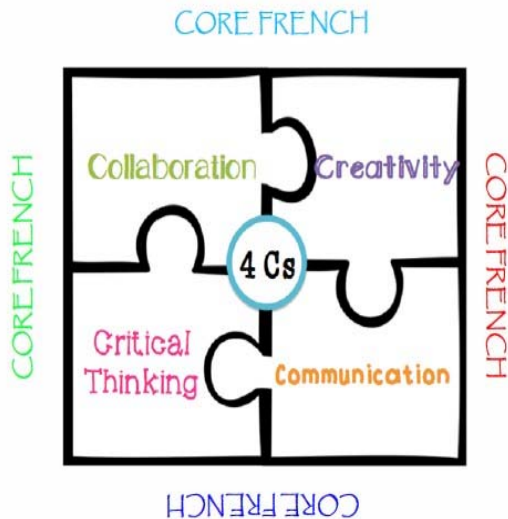
The redesign of the Core French program supports the development of students who are thinkers and communicators.
