Responsibility	<p>Fulfills responsibilities and commitment within the learning environment</p> <p>Completes and submits class work, homework and assignments according to agreed-upon timelines</p> <p>Takes responsibility for and manages own behaviour</p>	<p>Help your child set goals</p> <p>Take a few moments every day to chat about the school day and be a good listener: "How was your day?"</p> <p>Make sure to always check and sign the agenda</p> <p>Communicate regularly with your child's teacher</p> <p>Monitor and encourage your child's progress and homework completion</p> <p>Establish a balance between homework and other activities</p>
Organization	<p>Devises and follows a plan and process for completing work and tasks</p> <p>Establishes priorities and manages time to complete tasks and achieve goals</p> <p>Identifies, gathers, evaluates and uses information, technology and resources to complete tasks</p>	<p>Provide your child with a suitable environment for working at home</p> <p>Work out a specific time for studying and homework completion</p> <p>Provide your child with the proper tools and supplies to complete the homework (e.g., computer access, pen, pencil, eraser, pencil sharpener, scissors, tape, paper clips, ruler and highlighters.)</p> <p>Establish a balance between homework and other activities</p>
Independent Work	<p>Independently monitors, assesses and revises plans to complete tasks and meet goals</p> <p>Uses class time appropriately to complete tasks</p> <p>Follows instructions with minimal supervision</p>	<p>Check in occasionally by asking questions and talking about how the work is going</p> <p>Make sure a routine for completing homework is well established</p> <p>Participate appropriately in homework experiences and provide guidance as needed</p> <p>Promote independence as much as possible</p> <p>Create a checklist of work to be completed</p> <p>Help your child refer to and or access assignment criteria or rubrics</p>
Collaboration	<p>Accepts various roles and an equitable share of work in a group</p> <p>Responds positively to the ideas, opinions, values, and traditions of others</p>	<p>Establish a balance between homework and other activities</p> <p>Provide your child with extra-curricular activities</p> <p>Provide opportunities for your child to practice his/her French listening and speaking skills with others</p>

Builds healthy peer-to-peer relationships through personal and media-assisted interactions  
 Works with others to resolve conflicts and build consensus to achieve group goals  
 Shares information, resources, and expertise and promotes critical thinking to solve problems and make decisions

Help your child to build healthy peer-to-peer relationships by visiting the public library for French story time, attending summer camp, French plays and musical events  
 Encourage your child to work with others in group settings such as clubs, organizations and teams

<b>Self-Regulation</b>	<p>Sets own individual goals and monitors progress towards achieving them                  Seeks clarification or assistance when needed                  Assesses and reflects critically on own strengths, needs, and interests                  Identifies learning opportunities, choices, and strategies to meet personal needs and achieve goals                  Perseveres and makes an effort when responding to challenges</p>	<p>Help your child set goals                  Participate appropriately in homework experiences by clarifying expectations and providing guidance as needed                  Provide strategies that best suit your child's learning style                  Acknowledge your child's efforts                  Motivate your child to persevere when responding to challenges</p>

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
