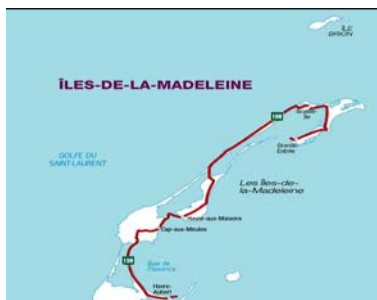

Students aged 12-14 and enrolled in French Immersion or French language education will have the opportunity to attend camp in Îles-de-la-Madeleine at L'Istorlet Center Nautique camp July 13-19, 2014. This is a nautical camp with boogie boarding, wind surfing, sailing and more.

At the same site is the Sea Kayak Camp. You will explore, by sea kayak, caves and cliffs, and in the evening, you will camp at a safe harbor on the beach for the night; a great way to discover the Islands from a different perspective. This is for 15-17 year olds from July 13-19, 2014 as well.
